Young Kevin Gauvin has extra money to pay for his vital cancer treatments after nine motorcyclists raised \$11,000 during a 24-hour motorcycle tour.

Gauvin has undergone various expensive treatments in Quebec City, Montreal and Moncton that have added up to more than \$100,000 in medical bills for his family.

Motorcycle enthusiasts, ranging in age from 24-51, came to Coaticook from all over the province to take the extreme tour and help raise money for the boy from New Brunswick.

The 1,800 km round trip tour brought them from Coaticook up north to Chibougamau and back to the start again to a cheering crowd of more than 50 people.

This is the second annual 24-hour motorcycle tour to leave Coaticook and raise funds for cancer patients.
